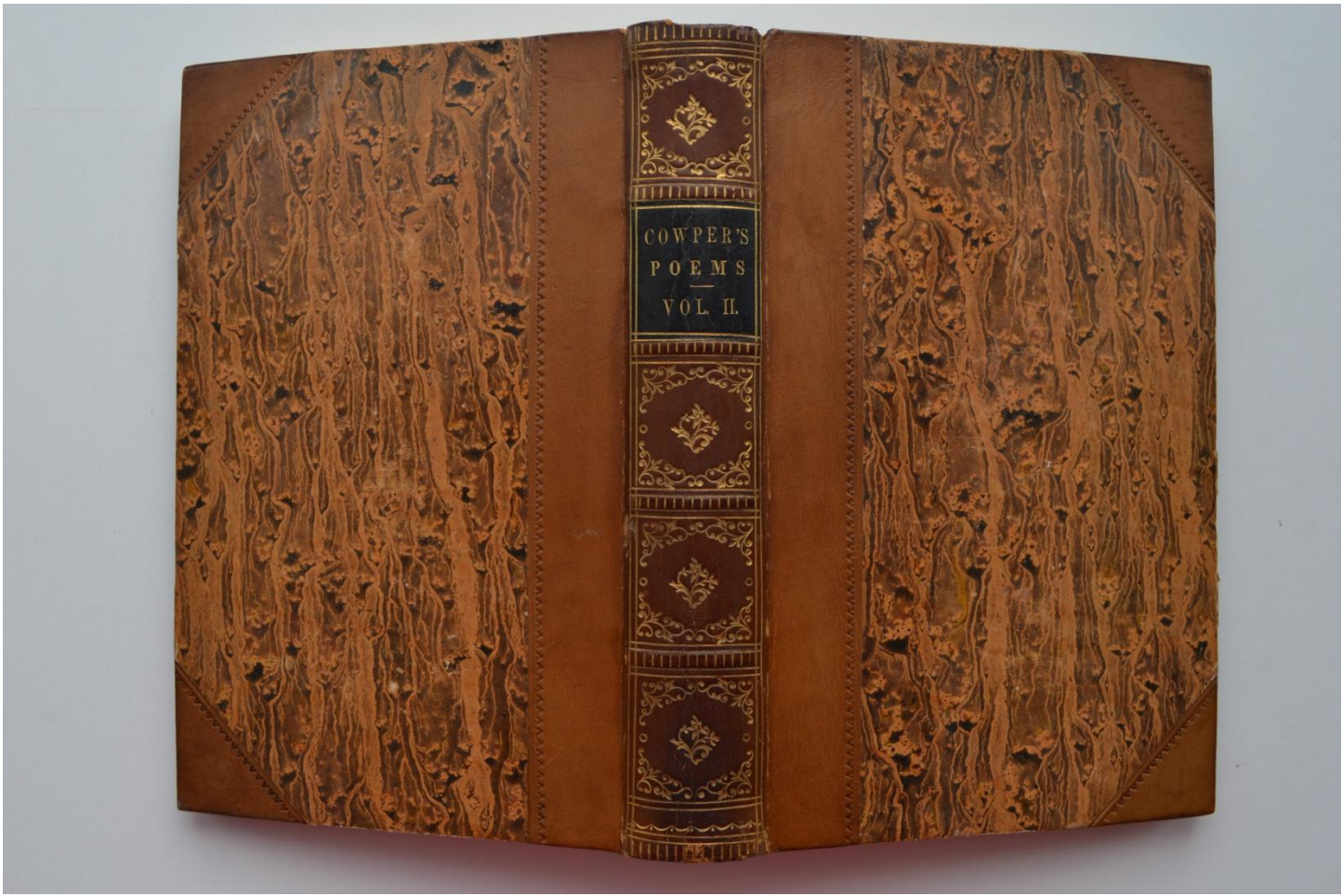
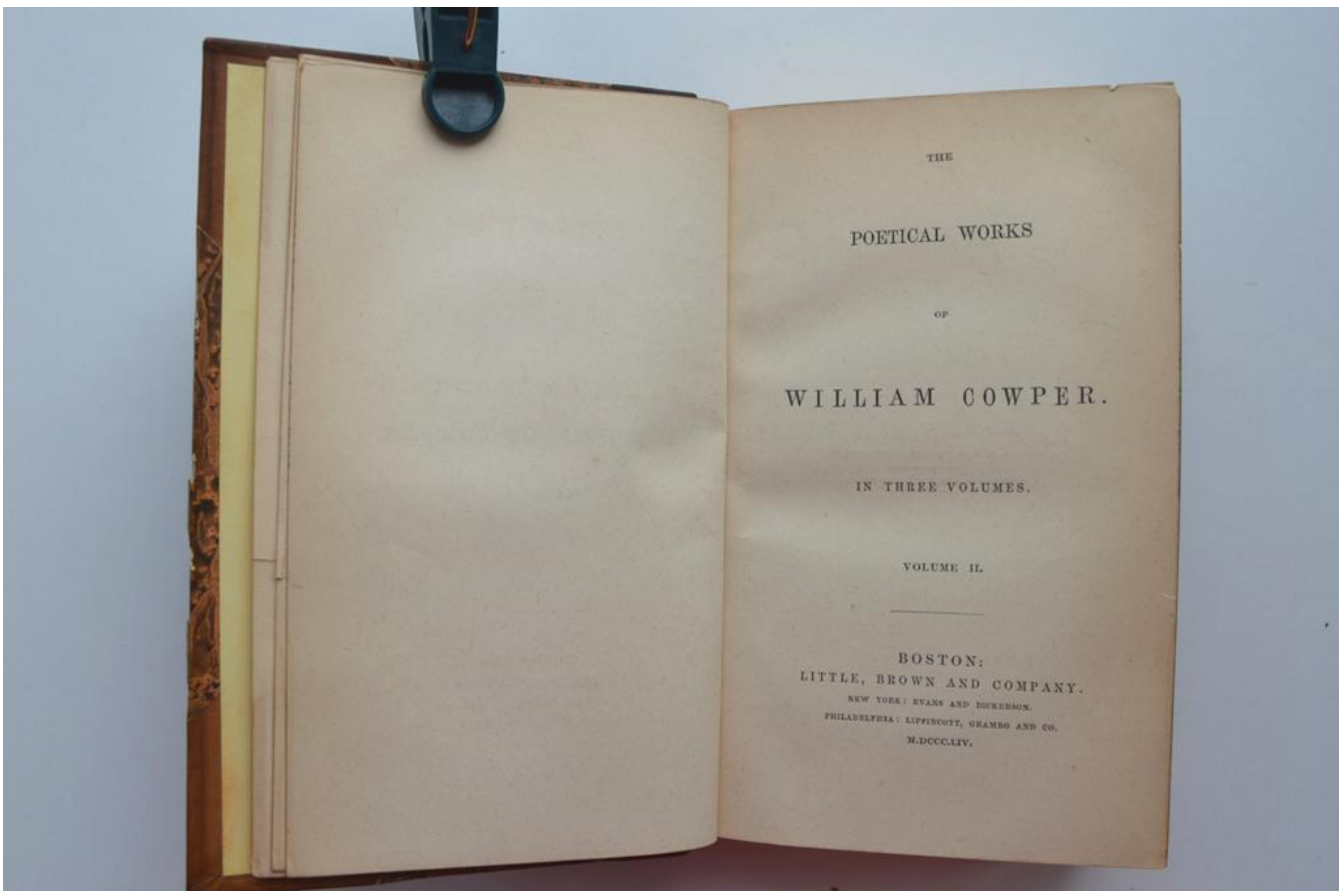
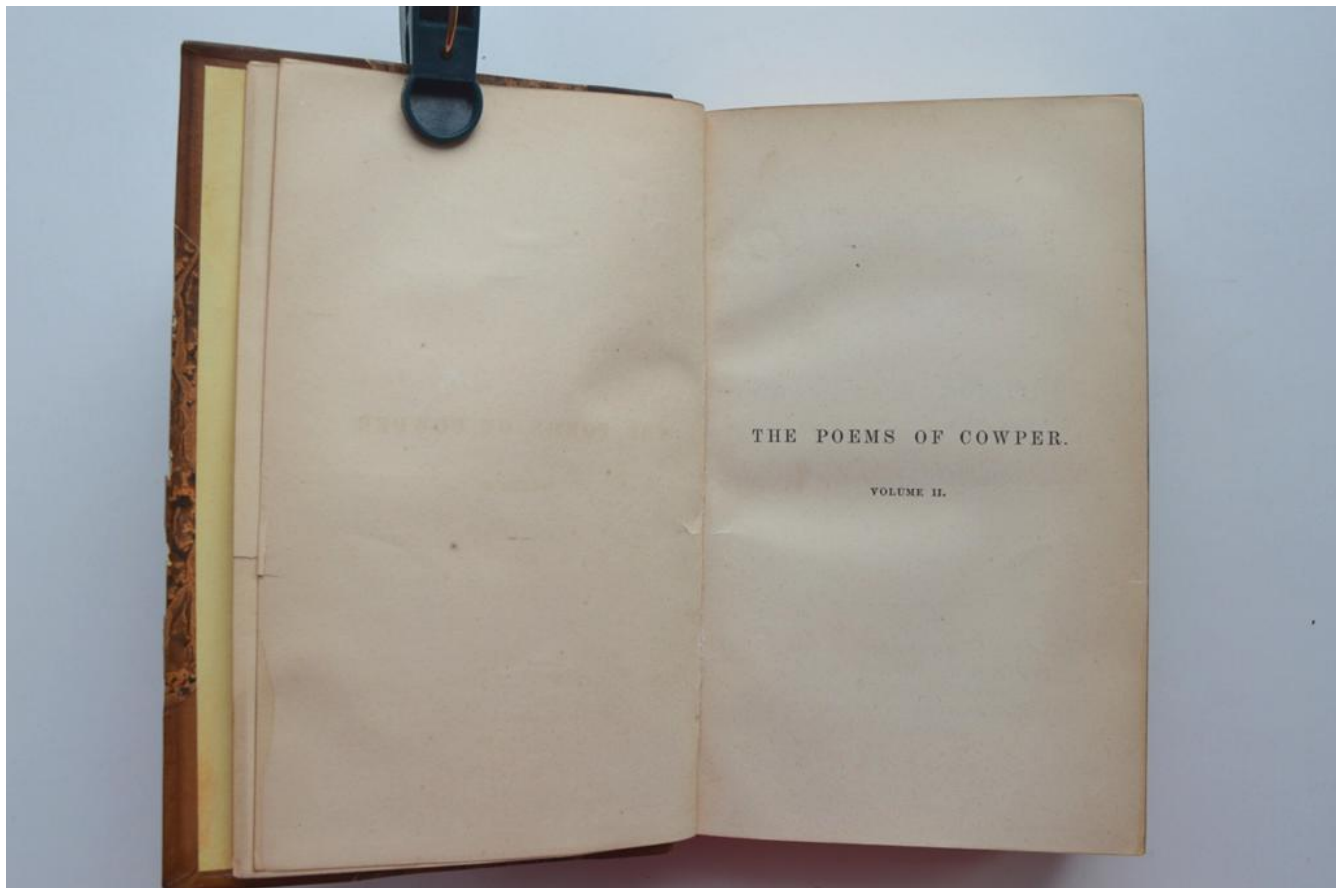

Description: Three Double Fore-Edge Books of William Cowper's Poems

Fore-edge Painting: Depicts Cowper's house "Orchard Side", in Buckinghamshire with borders illustrating the poems, "The Lily & the Rose," and "Epitaph on a Hare." Opposing side of Cowper in his summer house at Olney, Buckinghamshire with same aforementioned borders.
