




Description: Three Double Fore-Edge Books of William Cowper's Poems "The Poetical Works of William Cowper." Vol. I, II, and III. Boston; Little, Brown and Company. Printed by H.O. Houghton and Company, sterotyped by Stone and Smart, 1853-54. Each book with its own slipcase.

Fore-edge Painting: Depicting The Bell Inn, a former pub in Edmonton, London, surrounded by illustrations from the poems "The Yardley Oak," "Epitaph on Fop," and "Invitation to a Redbreast." Opposing side of Cowper's burial place at East Dereham Church, Norfolk, with the same aforementioned borders.
