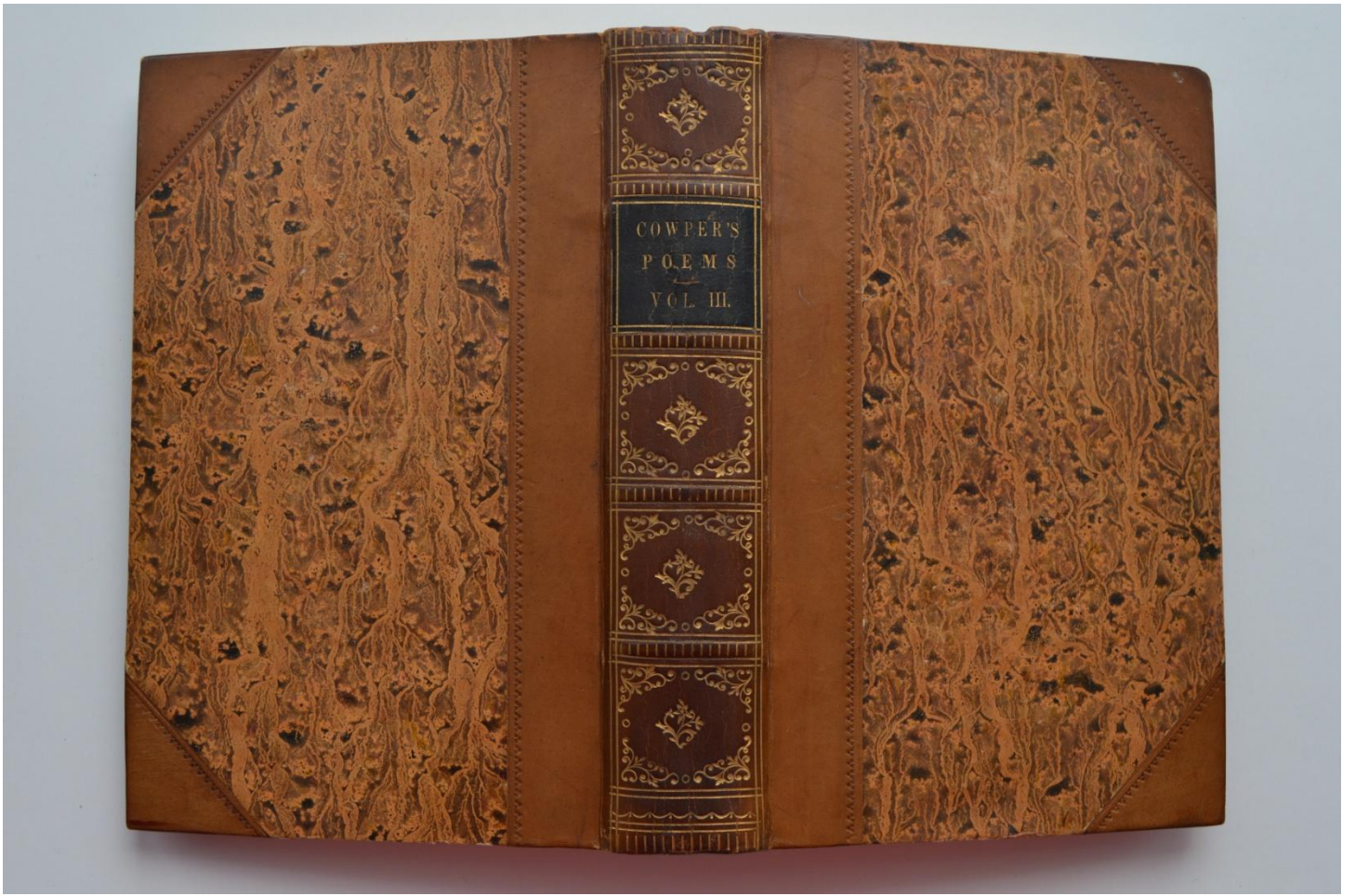
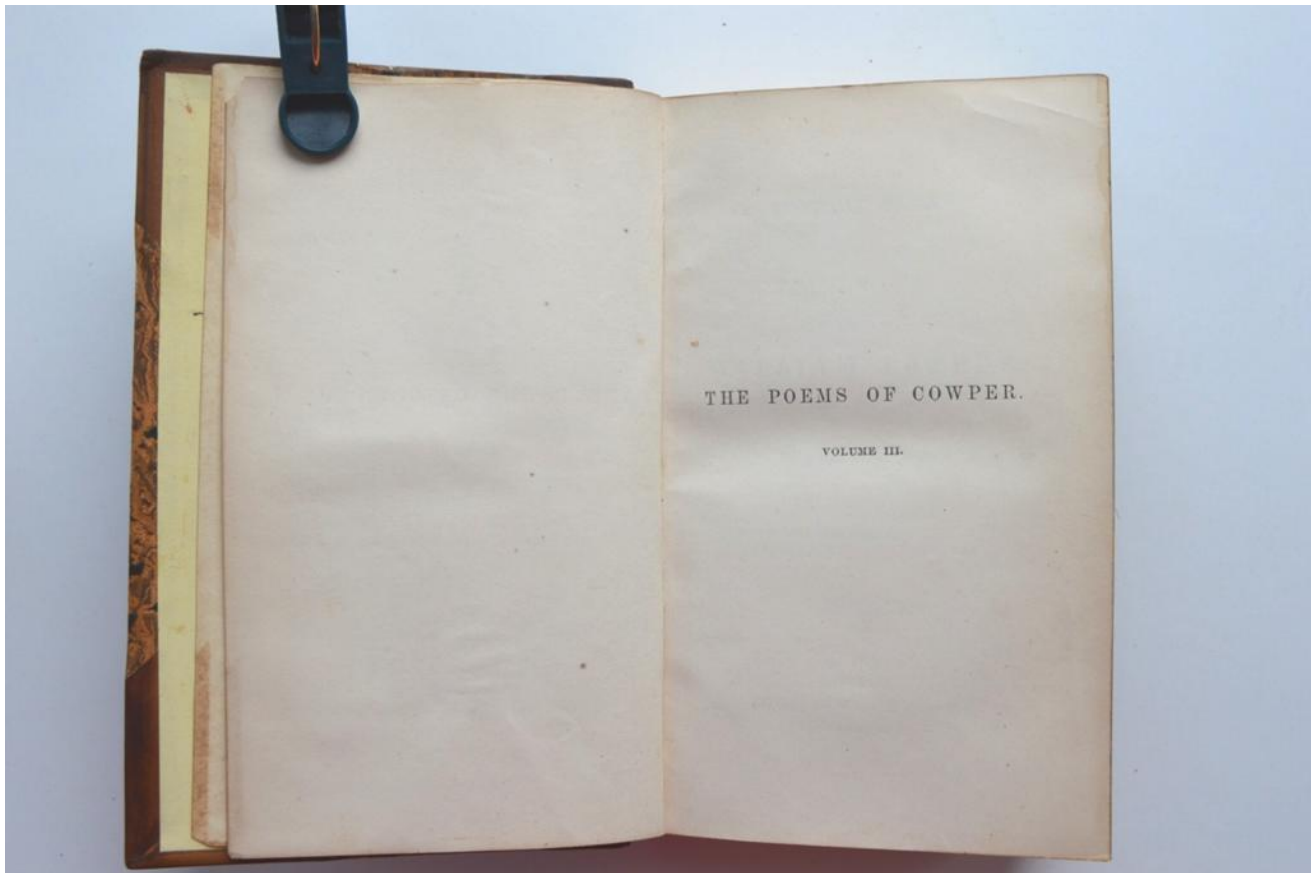

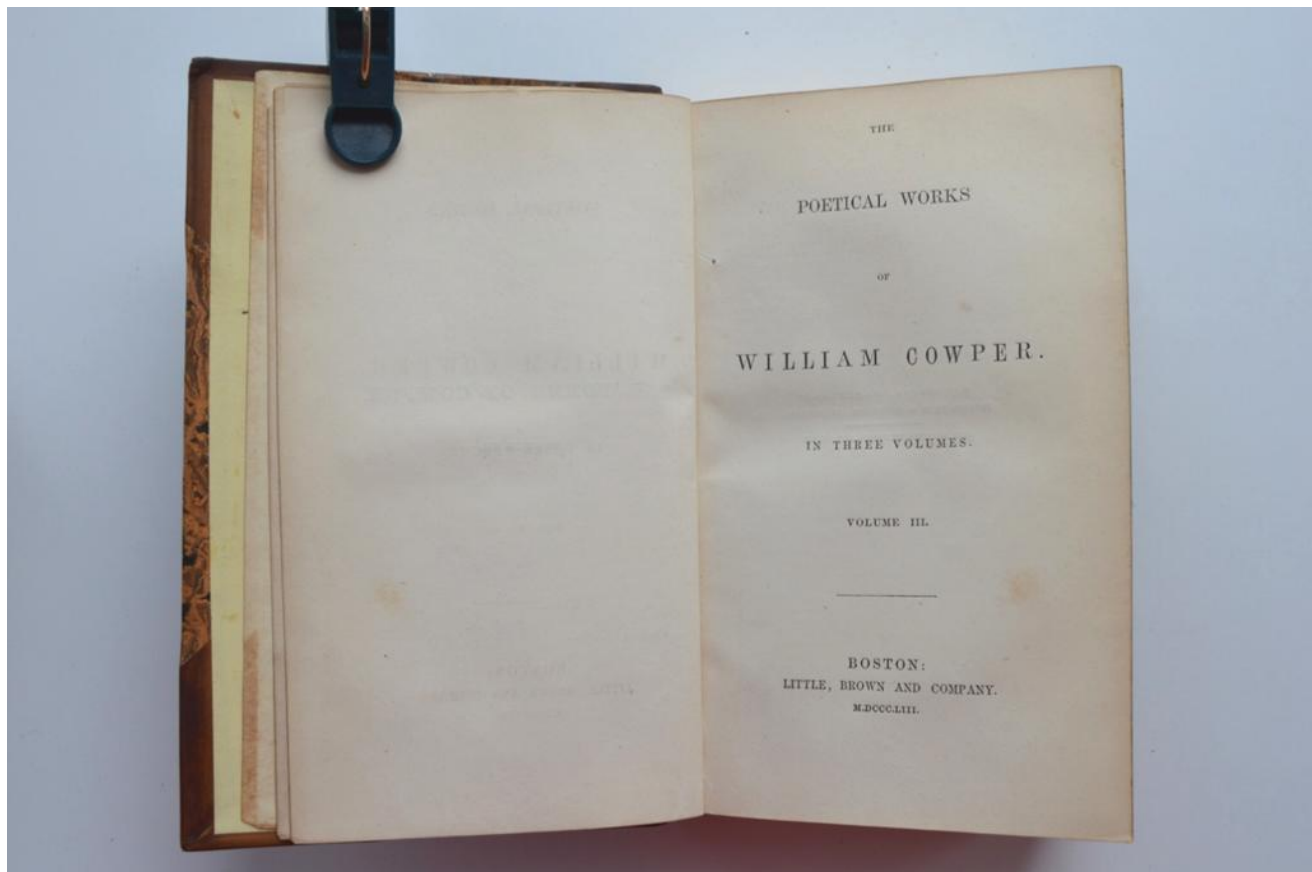

**Fore-edge Painting:** Depicting The Bell Inn, a former pub in Edmonton, London, surrounded by illustrations from the poems "The Yardley Oak," "Epitaph on Fop," and "Invitation to a Redbreast." Opposing side of Cowper's burial place at East Dereham Church, Norfolk, with the same aforementioned borders.
