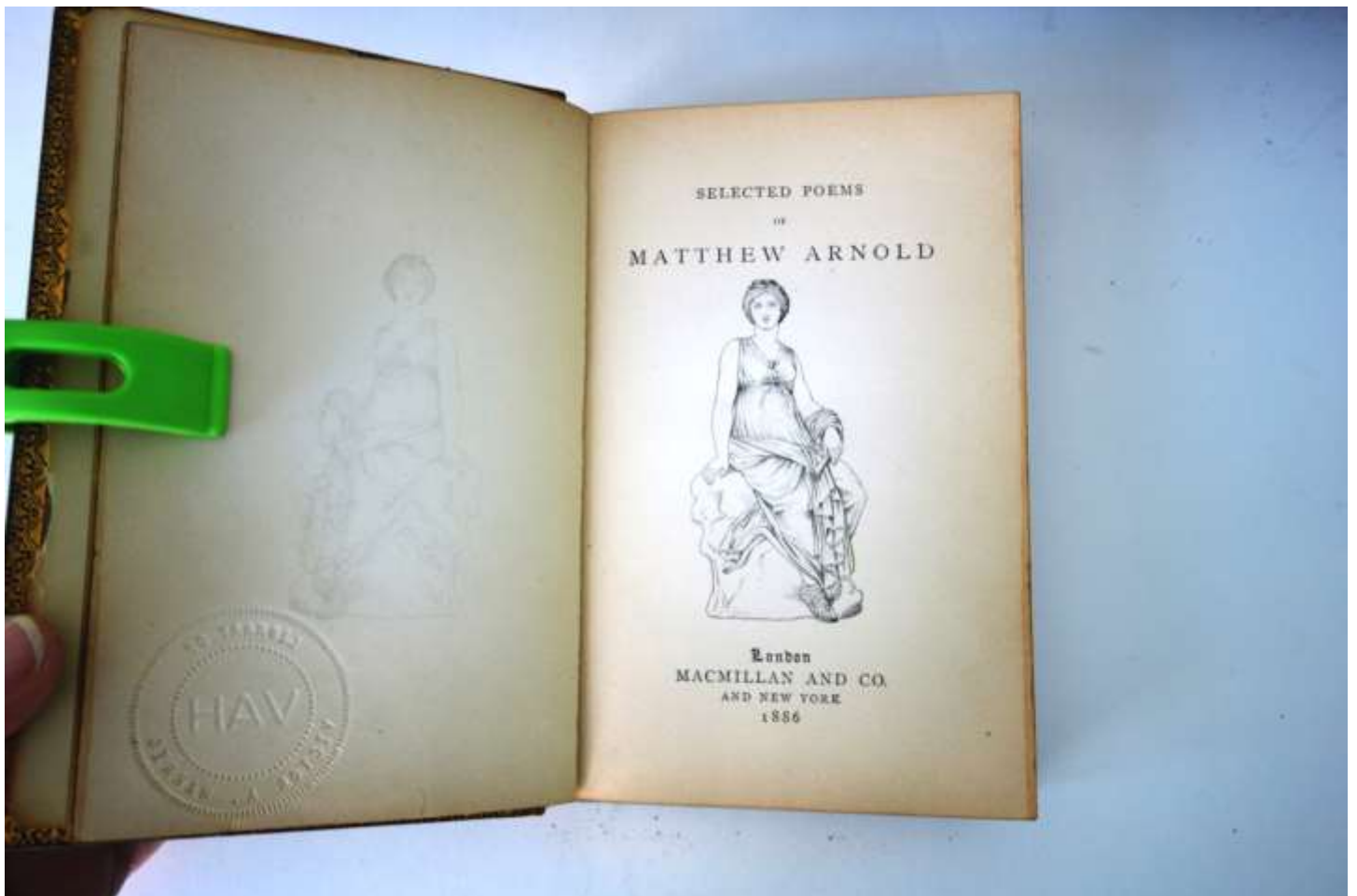
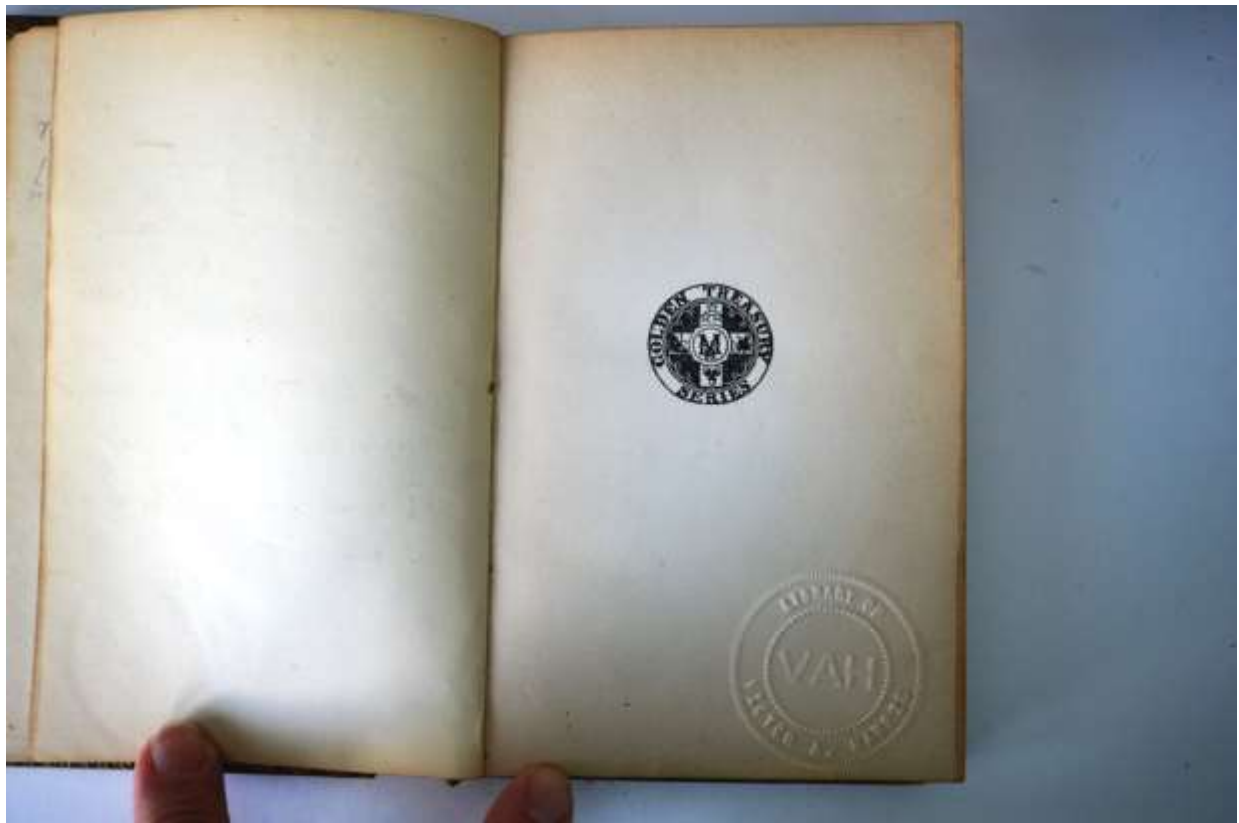


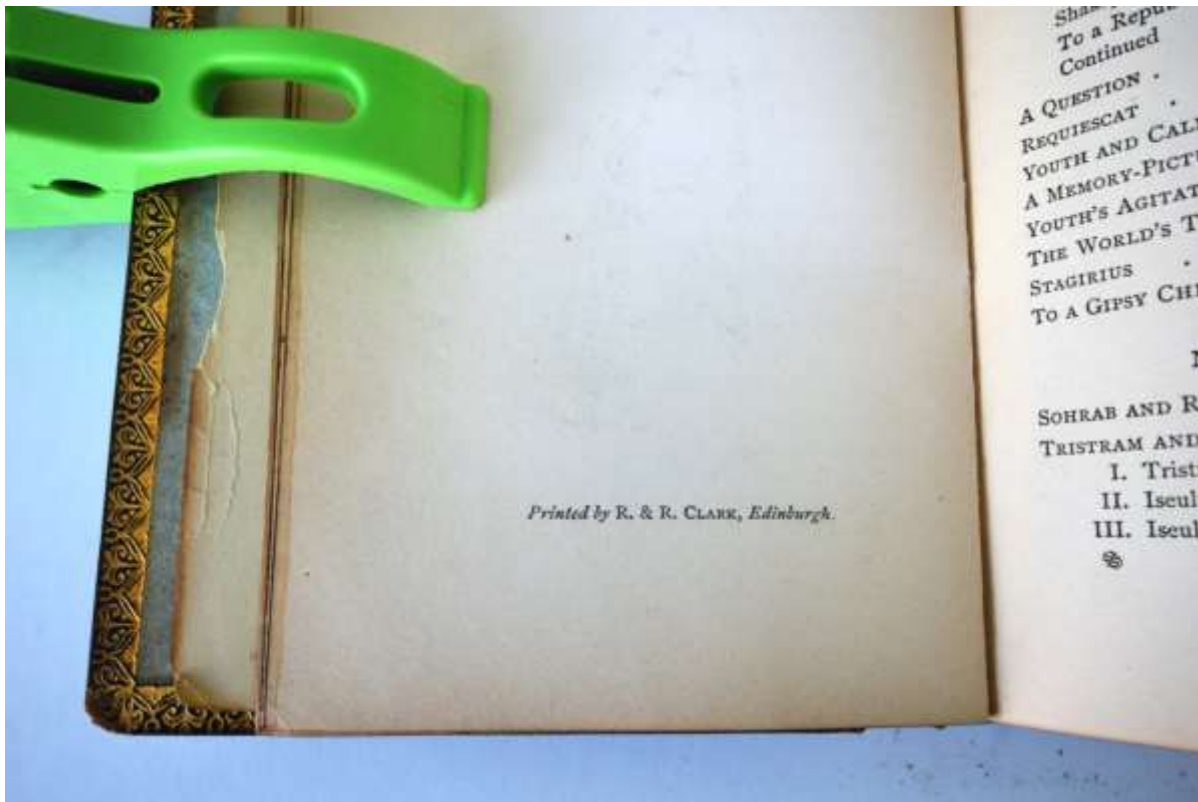


West, Rt. Hon. Sir Algernon (1832-1902), a Privy Councillor who began his career as a clerk in the Admiralty, and was secretary to Sir Charles Wood at the India Office before acting in the same capacity with conspicuous success for Mr. Gladstone. Became Chairman of the Board of Inland Revenue, and sat on several important Commissions. Published a volume of reminiscences, and a memoir of Admiral Sir Henry Kettle.
